

| <p>Identify text and author</p> | <p>INTRODUCTION - (one paragraph)</p> <p>Interesting Opening Sentence sentence to hook your audience's attention</p> <p>Background Info: any info necessary for your audience to understand essay</p> <p>Thesis: your position/argument about the prompt 1 sentence last sentence of intro (heart of your paper)</p> |
| <p>Everything must relate directly to thesis</p> | <p>BODY - (2-4 paragraphs)</p> <p>Topic Sentence: relates directly to one aspect of thesis gives main point of paragraph</p> <p>Introduce Evidence: explain the context of the quote (paraphrase)</p> <p>Evidence: quote from the text that supports your analysis</p> <p>Analysis: explanation about how the evidence proves your thesis</p> <p>Transition: Sentence connecting this paragraph to next</p> <div style="text-align: right; margin-top: 20px;">  <p>These three parts are interchangeable: repeat 2 times per paragraph</p> </div> |
| <p>No new information</p> | <p>CONCLUSION - (one paragraph)</p> <p>Restate Thesis: use different words to summarize your thesis</p> <p>Review Main points: summarize the main points you made in your paper</p> <p>Concluding Sentence: like a present; this sentence wraps up your whole essay</p> |
